Policy Highlight

Grade Replacement

Who is eligible?

Undergraduate students with grades from UNC

How many credits can I affect on my transcript with the policy?

Grade Replacement can only be applied once per course for a maximum of six (6) courses.

Which grades are eligible?

Grade replacement can be used regardless of previous grade earned.

Are grades deleted from the transcript?

All occurrences of a course are recorded on the transcript. However, only the most recent letter grade (A-F) attained for any given course will count towards the cumulative GPA, even if the most recent grade is lower than the previous grade attained.

When will grades be updated on the transcript?

Term and cumulative GPA will be recalculated during finals week each semester

Where do I get an application?

Grade replacement will not happen automatically; students must complete a Grade Replacement Application. Applications can be found via URSA under the Student Tab.

What's the drawback?

1. You must actually retake the course in which you received an undesirable grade.
2. Not all classes are eligible for grade replacement
3. Courses repeated under this policy may not be eligible for financial aid.
