## UNC Daniels Fund Ethics Initiative Grant Proposal For the Development of Ethics Teaching Resources

Through the Daniels Fund Ethics Initiative Grant, we are able to make internal grants available to UNC faculty for the development of teaching materials and resources related to ethics. Awards of up to \$2,000 will be given for the development of exercises, cases, and other teaching related materials and resources. ALL materials must include an instructor's guide. In rare instances, grants exceeding \$2,000 may be awarded for larger, more involved projects as approved by the UNC Daniels Fund Ethics Initiative Fellows.

The amount of the award will be determined by the quality, completeness, the student impact of the teaching resource, and the application of the Daniels Ethical Principles. Very rough guidelines would be that a very complete, high-quality case of 10+ pages with end of the case questions and an instructor guide would probably warrant a \$2,000 award. A shorter case that is often found at the end of a textbook chapter with end of the case questions and an instructor guide might be a \$1,000 award. Exercises used in class with an instructor guide might be \$500. These are rough guidelines and the quality of the resource is very important in determining the award.

Proposals will be reviewed by the UNC Daniels Fund Ethics Initiative Fellows. A determination of whether the proposal seems appropriate to be funded and at what amount will be made and communicated back to the submitter. Submitters are welcome to revise and resubmit if the initial proposal is not approved at the level expected. The determination of the amount of funding will be made once the completed project is submitted to the UNC Daniels Fund Ethics Initiative Fellows.

**A condition of the grant is that material must be posted to the Daniels Fund Ethics Initiative website, therefore, the author must have rights to the copyright or permission to post the material to a website (i.e., the author cannot have signed away the copyrights to a journal).** Although posted to the Daniels Fund Ethics Initiative website, *the author retains the copyrights*. The completed project must be posted to the Daniels Fund Ethics Initiative through approval of the UNC Daniels Fund Ethics Initiative Fellows before another grant request will be considered. Additionally, this teaching resource must be shared with other UNC faculty through a Teaching Roundtable or another appropriate mechanism approved by the Daniels Fund Ethics Initiative Fellows.
