The Network and Information Systems Security Minor is designed for students who are interested in developing a skill set and knowledge base of security issues for computer networks and accounting information systems. The minor provides a background of network infrastructure, protocols, and software. Minors will gain knowledge about industry operating systems, security strategies and relevant products and equipment. Students with this minor will be introduced to accounting concepts and accounting fraud detection.

Admission to the minor requires that a Business major be in academic good standing in both the Monfort College of Business and the University of Northern Colorado. A non-Business major who wishes to add or change to a Network and Information Systems Security Minor must have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 on at least 15 credit hours and obtain written approval from the Department of Accounting and Computer Systems, Monfort College of Business. Non-Business majors who have a GPA between 2.25 and 2.49 may apply for admission from the Department of Accounting and Computer Information Systems, Monfort College of Business, Kepner 2090.

Because of specific degree requirements, Business majors need to take the following courses in addition to their required emphasis and emphasis elective courses:

- Accounting emphasis must take BAAC 322, BACS 371, BACS 380 and BACS 382 to complete the NISS minor.
- Computer Information Systems emphasis must take BAAC 322, BAAC 328, BACS 371, BACS 382, and one additional CIS elective to complete the NISS minor.
- Finance, General Business, Management, and Marketing emphases will need to take BAAC 322, BACS 371, BACS 380, AND BACS 382 to complete the NISS minor.

Computer Proficiency Exam or BACS 101 may be taken concurrently with BAAC 220 and is a prerequisite for BACS 300.
