Faculty members from academic disciplines and applied fields provide a critical framework for students to build their perspective, knowledge, and skills to engage in entrepreneurship. Students in the minor develop entrepreneurial mindsets, gain deep knowledge of opportunity discovery, venture creations, and entrepreneurial ecosystems, and engage in ideation, business planning, small business management, and networking with local entrepreneurs.

Admission to the minor requires good academic standing with the University of Northern Colorado.

Students are expected to complete the prerequisites for all courses in the minor.
