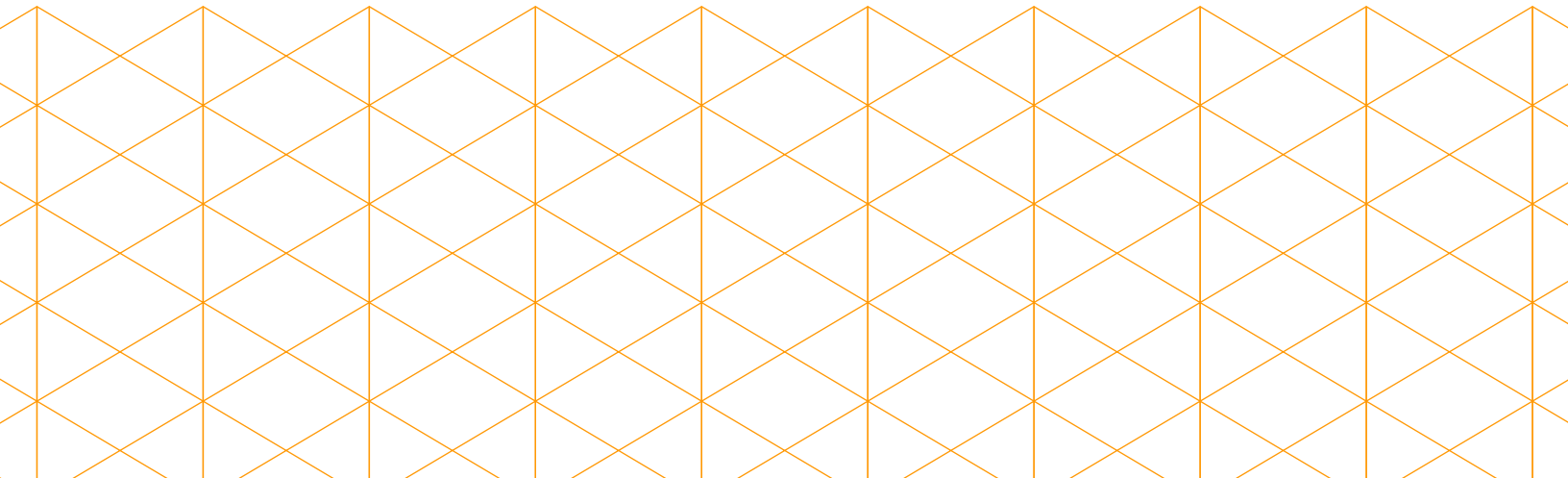

1 Student Sign Up

There are 2 ways students can create a BFE account.

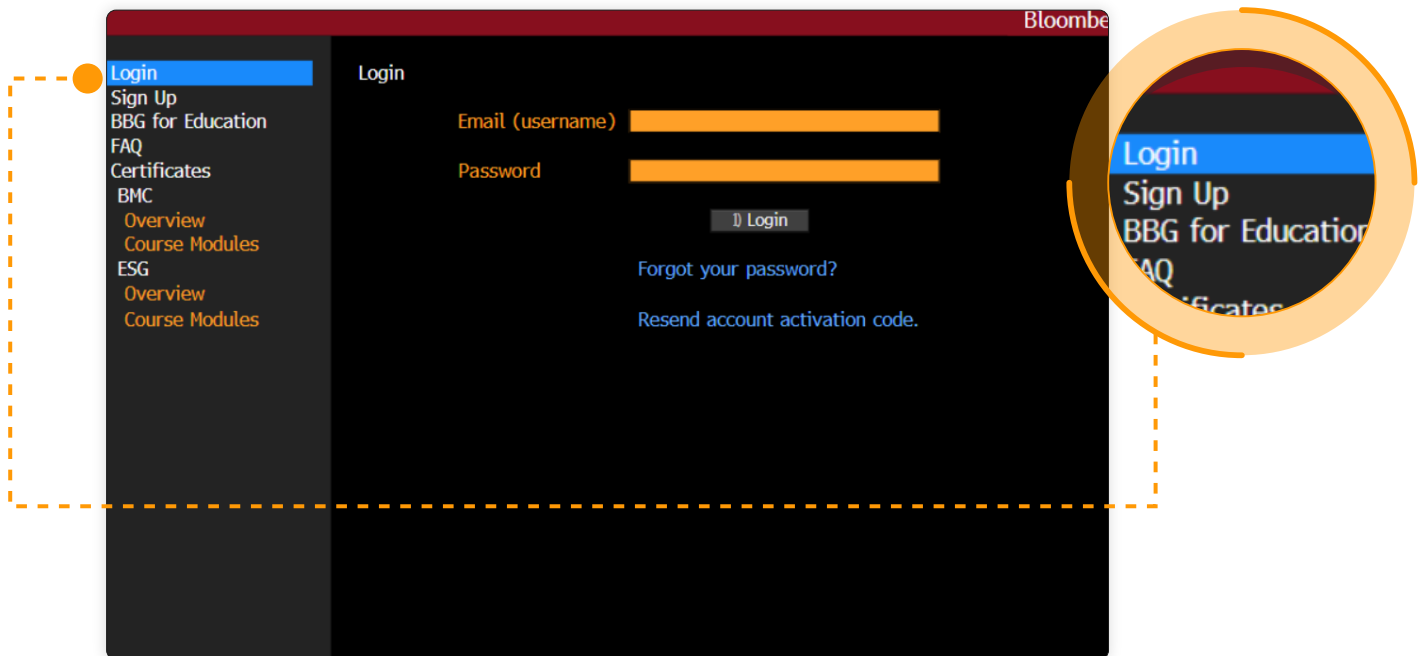
Method 1

If you have Bloomberg Terminal access please run the function {BCER<GO>}, click on the Sign Up in the upper left of the page.

Make sure you add your university email domain if you have one.

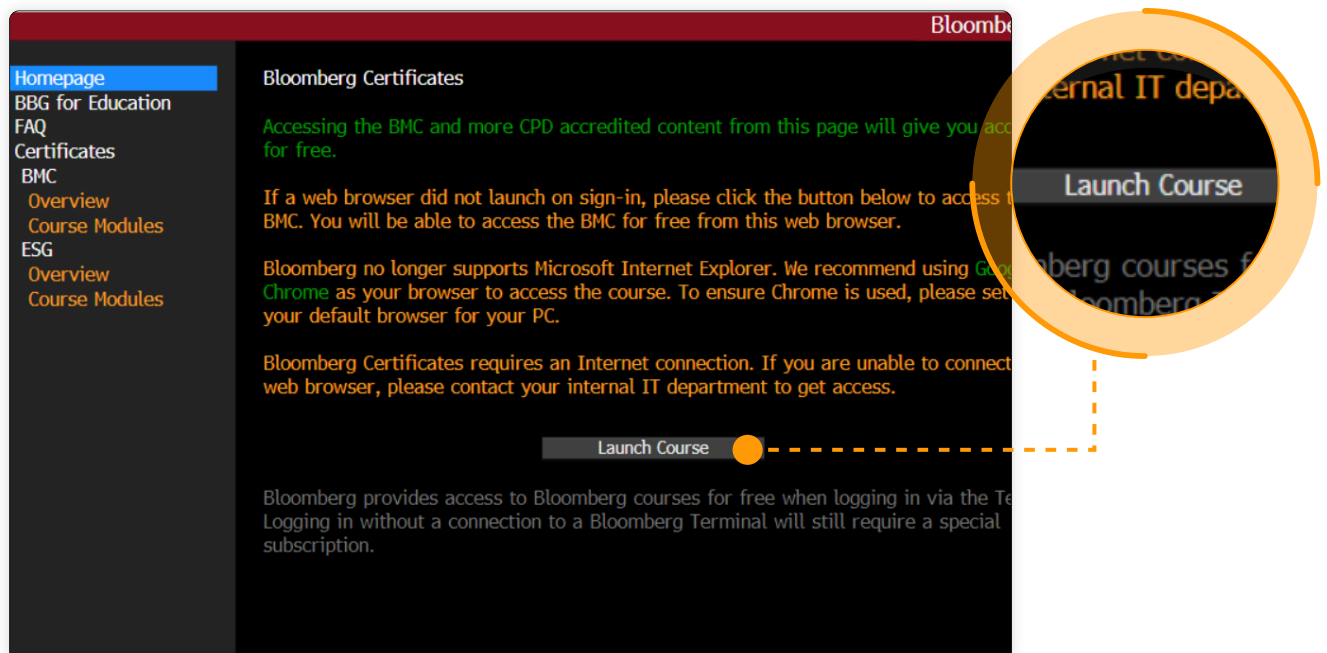




Method 2

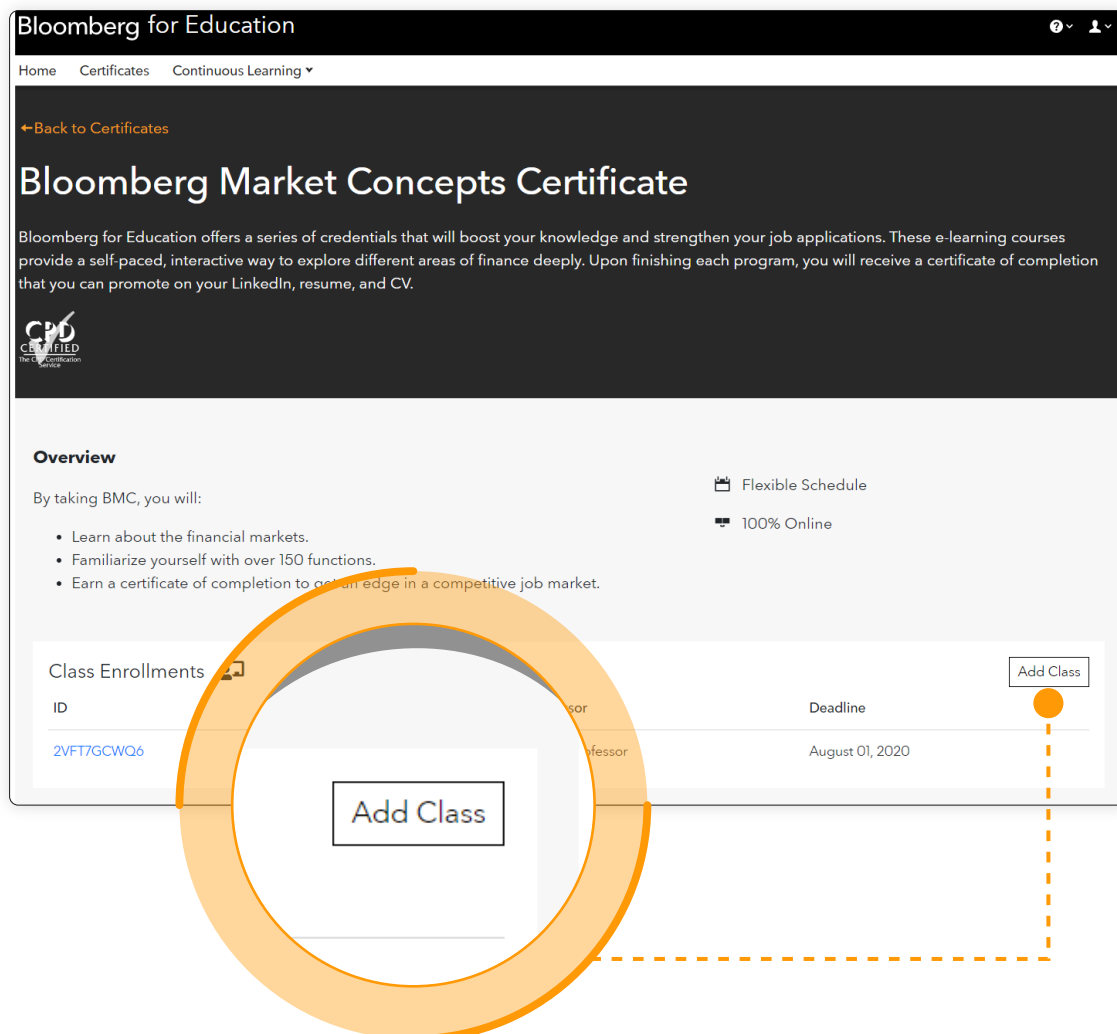
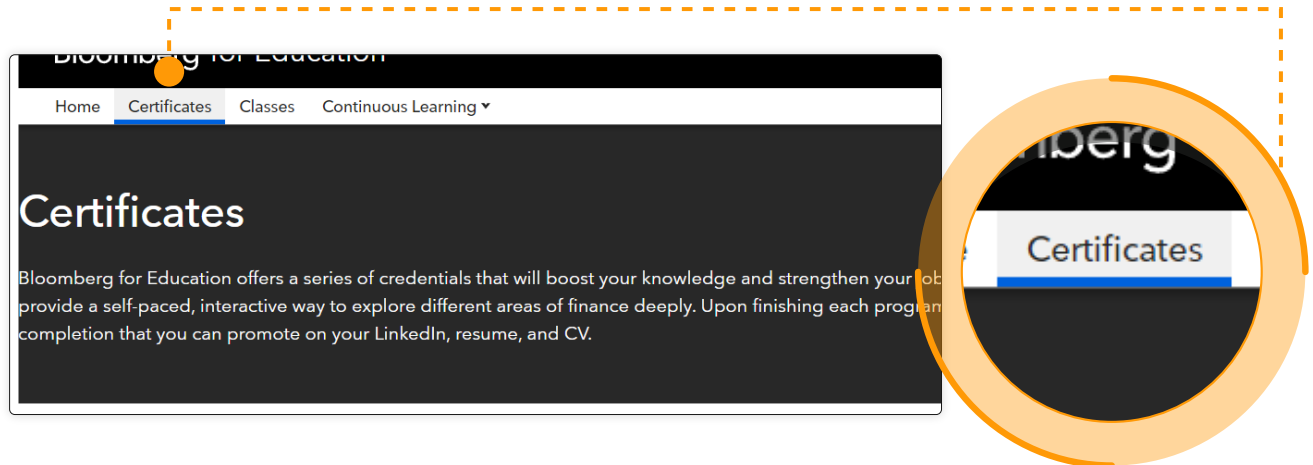



Student FAQ

- Does my institution have access to free web access?

Institutions with 5+ paid Bloomberg Terminals have unlimited web access.

Institutions with 4 paid Bloomberg Terminals have 300 web access per calendar year.

Institutions with 3 or less paid Bloomberg Terminals can access for free via the {BCER<GO>} terminal function. Alternatively, students can purchase web access for \$149 each.

If you are not sure how many paid Bloomberg terminals there are in your institution please reach out to us via bbg.edu@bloomberg.net or reach out to your terminal representative.
